Subject: Annual Asbestos Notification

In keeping with the Federal & State regulations, we at this time wish to inform (or remind) you of a presence of asbestos at St. Edward School.

In the summer of 1988 the school was inspected by AIMP of Metairie, LA. The school was found to have asbestos present in some of the building materials used in the construction of the facility. The materials were determined to be "NON-FRIABLE" (which means that the asbestos present in the materials ability to become airborne and present health problems is limited, provided it is not disturbed.) The materials in particular are the vinyl asbestos floor tiles in some classrooms & hallways. The tiles were found to be in "excellent" condition. Because of the condition of the materials, removal was not required and was encapsulated.

In 1988, St. Edward School put in place an Asbestos Management Plan, and does six month inspections of the facility to assure the materials in question have not changed status. The Management Plan and all related information are on file in the school office.

The Safety of the children and staff at St. Edward School is of utmost concern to those persons involved with the Management of the plan, and any change in the school condition, regarding asbestos will be forwarded to you.
